Please respect the safety of all school users.

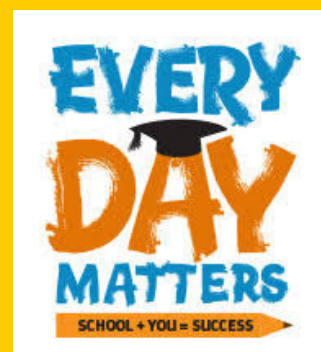


ASSEMBLIES
