CLACKS YOUTH FORUM

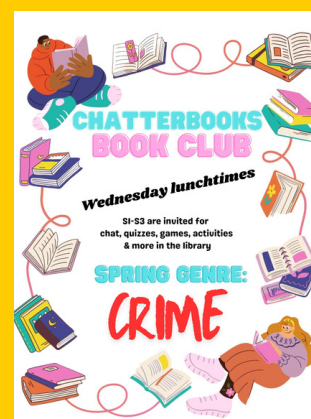
We were delighted that Charlie was able to represent Lornshill Academy and the Clacks Youth Forum at the 25th Scottish Parliament Anniversary celebrations.

LOCAL LANDMARK DRAWING COMPETITION

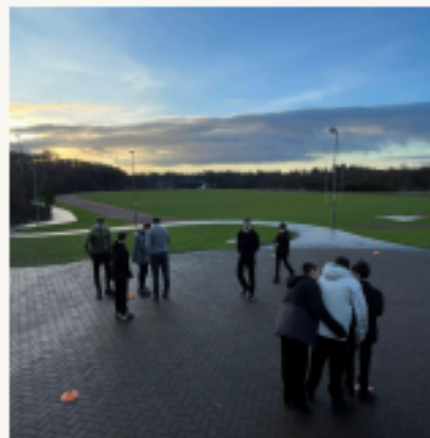
What is your favourite landmark in the local community? Is it a beautiful viewpoint? Docks on the river? Or even your local Greggs?
