Our next online session will be held in March, and we would be delighted to welcome even more parents and carers. Invitations will be sent out closer to the date.

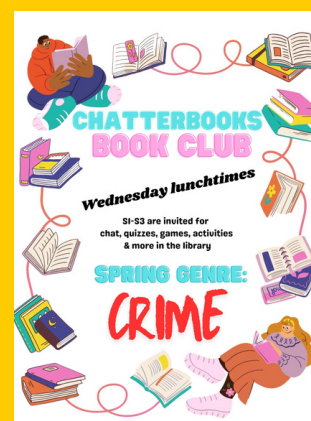
LORNSHILL FARM
