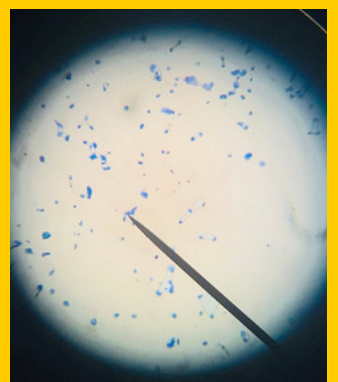
FAMILY LENDING LIBRARY
