ART EXHIBITION

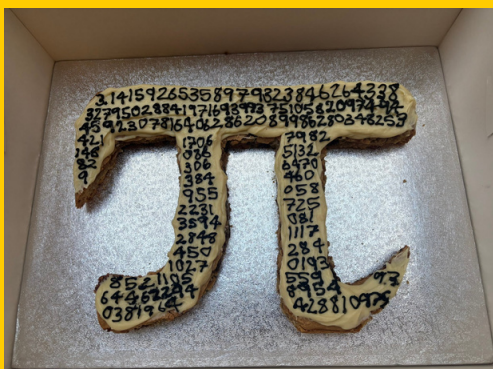
Last week's Art Exhibition was a huge success. It was great to see students' faces when they saw their artwork on display. Thank you to all who attended to show their support for this.
