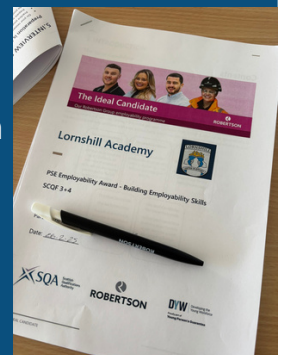
BOOK FAIRIES DELIVERIES

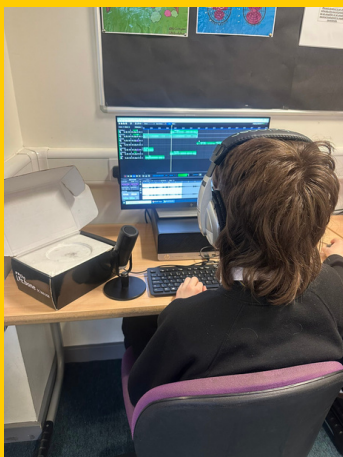
PARTNERSHIP WORKING WITH ROBERTSON'S CONSTRUCTION
