

WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING AT LORNSHILL? 27/02/26

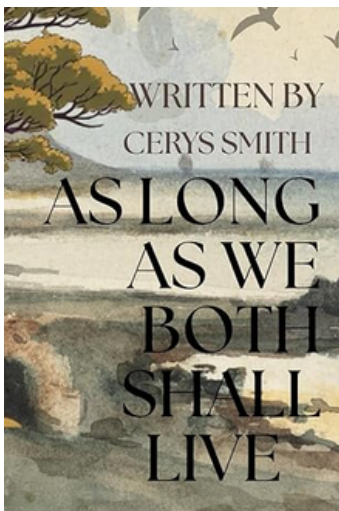
