Dear S4-S6 Parent/Carer,

As you will be aware, our local area has recently experienced a rise in positive cases of Covid19; this has obviously impacted on our school, and other nearby schools.

From Friday 21st May until Friday 11th June S4-S6 pupils will attend school when:

- They are scheduled to undertake an assessment;
- They are invited by their teacher to attend a Supported Study session focusing on assessment preparation;
- They are invited to attend school to complete unfinished coursework or unit assessments.

This is now one week earlier than planned, however, it is hoped that this will lessen the potential for young people to have to self-isolate, as they are less likely to have had close contact in school with someone who has subsequently tested positive for Covid-19.

Assessments that were due to be carried out on Friday 21st May and Monday 24th May will now be rescheduled, along with some adjustments to timings of other assessments. A new assessment timetable will be made available on the school website by end of day Friday 21st May and the link will be sent to all parents and pupils.

We will also make available limited space within school for young people to undertake independent revision, should they not be able to work from home.

At the moment, we expect to be able to welcome our returning S4 and S5 pupils back to school in the week beginning the 14th of June.

We understand that this has been a challenging time for all our young people and their families, please be assured that we will be working to ensure that all pupils achieve the grades they deserve.
