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As the mornings get lighter and the mercury on the thermometer starts to rise (hopefully!), it is clear that we are already making very quick progress through January. It was clear from the moment our students returned that there was a real drive to have a really successful year and we appreciate your ongoing support to ensure this happens.

Unfortunately however, COVID-19 still plays a big part in all of our lives and as was the case before Christmas, we would encourage all students, staff and families to be testing frequently each week. LFD testing kits can be collected from our main office. A reminder also that face coverings are mandatory in all areas of our school building unless students are eating or drinking in the social area at interval or lunchtime. We continue to issue hundreds of face coverings a week for those who do not bring their own and would ask for your support in helping to reduce this by reminding your child to bring their own each day.

We ended last week with a mock fire evacuation to ensure that in the unlikely event of this happening for real, our students and staff are able to exit the building safely and swiftly. We were delighted by how everyone conducted themselves and made their way to their muster points promptly.

This week, our S3 students will receive their immunisations for Diptheria/Tetanus/Meningitis if their consent forms have been returned. These immunisations have been scheduled for Wednesday with catch-up immunisations also being offered for S4-6 students from 9.30-12.25pm on Thursday.

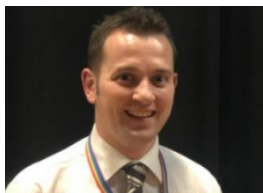

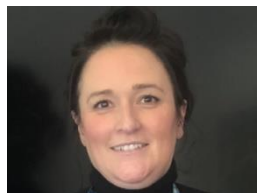
