There has been a short delay to sharing further information around our S2 pathways, however this will be sent to directly to our S2 students in due course.

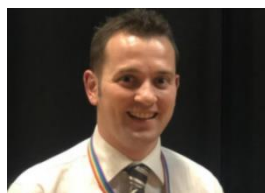

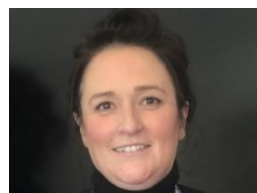
