As we enter the final week before our Spring holiday, we would like to take the opportunity to thank our families for their ongoing support through what has been a challenging term since Christmas. When we return after the holiday, we will hopefully be in a position where some of the current restrictions are removed and start to return to a little bit of normality. We finish school at our normal time this Friday (3pm) and all students are due to return at 8.55am on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> April.

For the time being however, we continue to issue a reminder that face coverings are mandatory when students and staff are moving around the building in the corridors. We continue to need to issue dozens of face coverings on a daily basis and would really appreciate it if you could ensure that your child arrives at school each day with their own covering.

When we return to school after the holiday on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> April, our S4-6 students will have only four days remaining before they embark upon study leave. Further to this, our one way system around the school will be discontinued after the holiday and students should use the quickest route to each of their classes at period changeover times.

When it comes to parking and visiting Lornshill Academy by car, we would ask all families to use the arrangements in place for this. If you are dropping a student off then this should be done at the drop off point on Tullibody Road. Recently, there have been a large number of families dropping students off in the staff and visitors' car park or the disabled parking area at the top of the school. This has resulted in unnecessary congestion and one of our students needing to take their wheelchair across the road due to being unable to get parked in a designated parking space. We respectfully ask all families to avoid dropping off students on school grounds to prevent such issues arising again in the future.

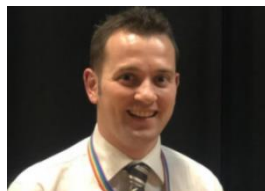

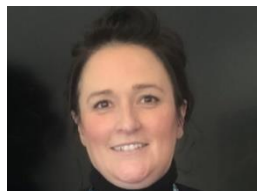
