Lornhill's Reading Leadership Group is growing! Our new members have thrown themselves into helping our core team run Reading Schools activities. They have provided welcome support in our mission to build a reading culture at Lornhill.

Celebrating Books & Reading

During the Autumn and Winter terms we celebrated National Poetry Day, Book Week Scotland and Empathy Action Month. Pupils have enjoyed numerous activities including poetry and Scottish titles competitions, and making origami bookmarks. An empathy exchange bake sale raised £80 for The Gate's foodbank. Four of our Empathy Champions have visited our P7 cluster primaries and gifted each school a box of empathy boosting books.





Author Visits

S1 and S2 pupils enjoyed a visit from Victoria Williamson, as part of our Read for Empathy Project, which was funded by the Government's School Library Information Fund. S3-6 PSE classes enjoyed watching the thought-provoking Authors Live event with Falkirk born author Alan Bissett, on his new non-fiction book 'Lads: A Guide to Respect and Consent for Teenage Boys'.
