CHATTERBOOKS

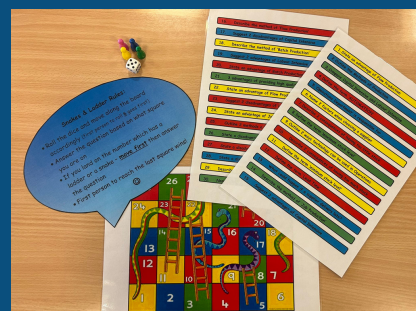
There has been lots going on in our recent Chatterbooks sessions including Alfie & Aurora's "Horror" presentation.
