Provide regular updates on student progress.	Yes	Judgements are entered on Didbook termly and Groupcall messages sent home to remind families to look at these. Summaries of learning will be sent home twice yearly (Christmas and before timetable change) as an additional way of providing updates.
Ensure that the feelings and views of all pupils are fully considered.	Yes	Our Parliament allows a vehicle for the views of pupils to be heard and acted upon – this has been impactful so far (e.g. PE Uniform; Mobile Phones). However, our self-evaluation programme also provides more opportunities for the voices of all students to be gathered, reflected upon and actions taken as a result. Termly Pupil Voice questionnaires also allow us to gather the views of our young people regularly.
Organise more opportunities for families and learners to develop their skills together.	Yes	We are putting the finishing touches our “Family Partnership Plan” and this will be shared with you next term. However, this plan aims to offer more opportunities for families and students to learn together.
Get rid of mobile phones, they cause nothing but problems in schools.	Yes	We are currently reviewing our mobile phone policy and will be in a position to share this in April 2024.
